



CLUB ETIQUETTE

Courtesy on court

- Play fairly and enjoy the tennis you play
- When moving around the courts, be aware of other games in play. Wait until a point has finished before moving down the centre of the courts
- Match play takes priority over social play.

Club night guidelines

- Play mixed tennis at all times unless not enough men/ladies to mix up
- Play doubles, rather than singles, unless there are insufficient players
- Play to 7 games, so we can keep mixing around and no one waits too long.
- Those waiting to play get to join in after the 7 games

Looking after our facilities

- Footwear should be non marking, 'all court surface' footwear
- Lower the nets when you have finished playing
- Leave the club house tidy, wash up after yourselves and please take rubbish with you
- If you are last to leave, please ensure the clubhouse and all the gates are locked (including the car park gate). Leaving the keys in the key safe.
